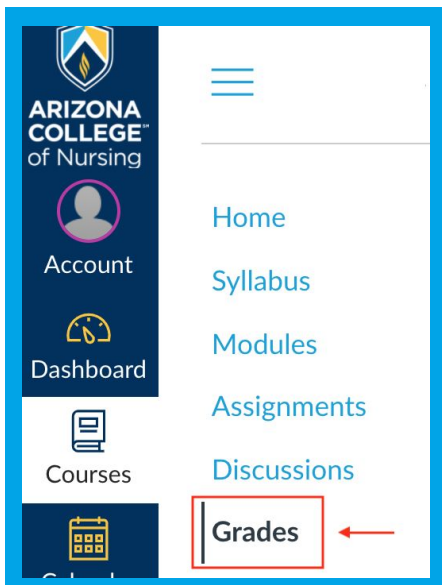


Viewing Rubrics in Canvas on Turnitin Assignments

Overview

Canvas rubrics may be used when Turnitin is enabled on an assignment. The rubric is a set of criteria that your instructor will use to grade your assignment. Before submitting your assignment, you can use the rubric to evaluate your own work and make sure your assignment fulfills the assignment requirements. This guide will assist you with locating and viewing a rubric for a Turnitin assignment prior to submission.

Step 1 | Access your Course Gradebook



Click the **Grades** link located on the course navigation panel.

Step 2 | Locate the Turnitin Assignment

Locate the assignment within the gradebook. Click on the **Assignment** link.

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Step 3 | Click the Show Rubric icon

To view the Turnitin assignment rubric prior to submission, in the top right corner of the page click on the **Show Rubric** icon or link.

Step 4 | Review the Assignment Rubric

The assignment rubric will populate on the right side of the page. Detailed rubrics with multiple criteria may require you to scroll down or to the right using the scroll bar on the side and bottom of the rubric window. To close the rubric window, click **Hide Rubric** or the **X** icon in the upper right-hand corner of the rubric window.
